

The Significance of Flowers

There are many ways to express yourself with flowers. The examples shown here depict some of the more common arrangement styles. Funeral and memorial tributes can be personalized by incorporating favorite flowers, colors or personal items such as embroidered pillows. - Casket or Urn Spray - These are usually selected by the spouse or immediate family members.
- Ledge Piece and Rosary - These are usually selected by the family (*not shown*).
- Family Pedestal Arrangements - These may be selected by the family for placement at both ends of the casket (*not shown*).
- Easel Sprays and Wreaths - These are usually selected by friends for placement around the casket, urn or memorial items.
- Vase Arrangements - These are usually sent by friends to either the place of ceremony or residence.
- Small Cross and Heart Pillows - These pieces are designed for placement inside the casket and usually represent the grandchildren and great grandchildren.
- Fireside Basket - These are usually sent to the place of ceremony by family or friends.
- Plants, Fruit and Food Baskets - These are an appropriate alternative to flowers. Plants may be sent to the place of ceremony while fruit and food baskets are typically sent to the residence.
